

PCSO Looking For Kidnapping Victim

At 11 p.m. on Thursday, Jan. 17, Danah Costales, 19, allegedly kidnapped her 2-year-old son, Christopher Lee Brady, from Arizona City. Authorities say it is extremely critical that Costales' son is located due to a current medical condition that could be life-threatening if not treated properly. Police say Costales is unaware of this medical condition due to her lack of involvement and custody of her son.

The child's grandmother was given custody of Costales' son by a Pinal County Superior Court Judge and Costales is aware of the court order. Costales made comments to a friend that she was going to kidnap her son and take him to New York where her sister is living.

Costales was notified by law enforcement on Jan. 17, and the court order was explained to her and she fully understood she

needed to turn the child over, but refused. Costales has yet to be located.
