PROPOSITION 100

PROPOSAL SUBMITTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION
 OFFICIAL TITLE: A RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN EXTENSION OF THE ALTERNATIVE EXPENDITURE LIMITATION FOR THE CITY OF APACHE JUNCTION.

DESCRIPTIVE TITLE: Pursuant to the Arizona State Constitution, this proposal establishes an extension of the alternative expenditure limitation (home rule option) for the City of Apache Junction for the next four years. Annually, the City Council will determine the amount of the alternative expenditure limitation for the fiscal year after at least one public hearing. This alternative expenditure limitation replaces the state-imposed expenditure limitation.

A "YES" vote shall have the effect of extending the alternative expenditure limitation (home rule option) for the City of Apache Junction.

A "NO" vote shall have the effect of not allowing the City of Apache Junction to extend the alternative expenditure limitation (home rule option) and to require expenditures of the city to be limited by the state-imposed expenditure formula.
